

FAQ

1. Where is the college situated?

- The college is centrally located in the city of Kolkata, adjacent to the busy Sealdah Station (1.1 km.) and College Street (1.8 km.). The present address of the college is 24/2, Mahatma Gandhi Road, Calcutta – 700 009.

2. How do I reach the college?

- The college is well-connected by railway, several bus-routes as well as by the metro railway.

3. What affiliation does the college have?

- The College is government-aided and recognized by the University of Calcutta and has been affiliated by the Bar Council of India.

4. What are the courses of study offered by the college?

- The college offers 5 years B.A. LL.B degree course. Students can pursue Honours in B.A. LL.B from the 3rd year during the course of their study. The college also offers 2 years LL.M course.

5. What are the admission procedures followed by the college for the respective LL.B and LL.M course of study?

- The students are selected through the Joint Entrance Examination conducted by the University of Calcutta for the B.A. LL.B degree course. For the LL.M course, the students have to appear for an Entrance Examination conducted by the college.

6. Who are eligible for the B.A.LL.B and LL.M course?

- Candidates who have completed their 12th standard from any recognized board, may apply for the B.A. LL.B degree. For the LL.M course, the candidates who have completed their B.A. LL.B degree, from any recognized University, are eligible to apply.

7. What is the course fee of the B.A. LL.B and LL.M course?

- For any queries related to course fee refer to the college website or contact the concerned department at the office.

8. Is there any provision for obtaining scholarships? What are they?

- Yes. Detailed information has been provided in the website.

9. How are the classes scheduled?

- All the classes take place between 6:30 am to 12:30 pm. For remedial or special classes, respective mentors are to be contacted.

10. What is the student to faculty ratio on campus?

- 50:1.

11. How available are the professors to the students?

- All the teachers are always available to help the students in their academic as well as other needs during the college hours, both inside and outside the classrooms. Students are always encouraged to freely converse with their teachers on relevant issues.

12. What are the future prospects by studying law?

- The college has a career counseling cell, which regularly keeps the students updated regarding the various job prospects by studying law.

13. Are there academic advising and counseling services available to the students?

- Yes.

14. Does the college provide hostel facility for the students?

- The College does not have hostel facility for the students at the present moment. However, interested students can contact the Student Committee to enquire about several provisions for accomodation.
